Success Rates:

IVF Own Eggs Success rates

The overall clinical pregnancy success rate per embryo transfer in 2024: 41 %

Broken down per age:

- Women under 35 years old: 49 %
- Women aged 35-40 years old: 36 %
- Women over 40 years old: 22 %

IVF With Donor Eggs Success Rates

The overall egg donation clinical pregnancy success rate per embryo transfer in 2024: 62 %

- Fresh donor eggs - single IVF cycle success rate per embryo transfer: 62 %
- Frozen donor eggs - single IVF cycle success rate per embryo transfer: 61 %
- Average number of embryos transferred per embryo transfer: 1,08

- The multiple birth rate (twins, triplets, etc.) in 2024: 4 %
- The frozen embryo clinical pregnancy rate in 2024: 39 %
- The embryo donation clinical pregnancy rate in 2024: 50 %
